PURPOSE

The purposes for which we collect, use, or disclose personal information will be limited to those which are related to our business and which a reasonable person would consider appropriate in the circumstances. We collect, use, and disclose personal information concerning our constituents for the follow reasons: to understand who our constituents are and how we may improve our services to meet their preferences and expectations; to respond to requests for information; and to meet requirements imposed by law. When you make a donation or become a supporter online, your name, address, telephone, email, and credit card information will be collected by Custom Donations (https://www.customdonations.com/privacy/) and Stripe (https://stripe.com/privacy). With the exception of your credit card information, this information is shared with KMTA so we can recognize your contribution, issue and provide you with a donation tax receipt, and establish a relationship and communicate with you. When you register to receive our newsletter, your name, address, and email will be shared with third-parties such as MailChimp for the fulfillment of our newsletters.

LIMITING COLLECTION

We will limit the amount and type of personal information collected to that which is necessary for our identified purposes and we will only collect personal information by fair and lawful means.

OTHER INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We use "Google Analytics" to collect information about use of this site. Google Analytics collects information such as how often users visit this site, what pages they visit, when they do so, and what other sites they used prior to coming to this site. Google Analytics plants a permanent cookie on your web browser to identify you as a unique user the next time you visit this site, the cookie cannot be used by anyone

but Google. Google's ability to use and share information collected by Google Analytics about your visits to this site is restricted by the Google Analytics Terms of Use (http://www.google.com/analytics/terms/ us.html) and the Google Privacy Policy (http://www.google.com/policies/privacy/).
