ALASKA OUTDOOR SCHOOL PACKING LIST

The following is a suggested list of items to bring. You do not need to purchase new things for Outdoor School, if you do not have an item(s) please contact your teacher or Outdoor School, we may have supplies that students can borrow. We suggest bringing older clothing and equipment that you already have around your home. The main thing is to have enough clothing to keep warm if the weather is cold and keep dry in case of rain. Choosing fleece or another warm, quick-dry fabric is better than cotton (which takes longer to dry).
