

## ALASKA OUTDOOR SCHOOL PACKING LIST

The following is a suggested list of items to bring. **You do not need to purchase new things for Outdoor School**, if you do not have an item(s) please contact your teacher or Outdoor School, we may have supplies that students can borrow. **We suggest bringing older clothing and equipment that you already have around your home. The main thing is to have enough clothing to keep warm if the weather is cold and keep dry in case of rain.** Choosing fleece or another warm, quick-dry fabric is better than cotton (which takes longer to dry).

### PLEASE LABEL ALL ITEMS WITH YOUR STUDENTS' FIRST AND LAST NAME!

#### ***SLEEPING GEAR***

- ☐ Warm sleeping bag
- ☐ Pillow
- ☐ Extra blanket
- ☐ Foam or inflatable sleeping pad

#### ***CLOTHING***

- ☐ RAINCOAT W/ HOOD
- ☐ WATERPROOF BOOTS
- ☐ RAIN PANTS
- ☐ WARM JACKET
- ☐ WARM HAT + GLOVES
- ☐ 4-5 pairs warm socks
- ☐ Thermal underwear/long johns/thick leggings
- ☐ Underwear (3 changes)
- ☐ 2 pairs of long pants (will be worn for hiking and learning/playing outside)
- ☐ Warm sweater or sweatshirt (fleece is best)
- ☐ 3-4 shirts (both short and long sleeved)
- ☐ Pajamas
- ☐ Indoor shoes

#### ***ZIPLOCK BAG OR TOILETRY BAG LABELED WITH YOUR NAME***

- ☐ Toothbrush and toothpaste
- ☐ Sunscreen
- ☐ Deodorant
- ☐ Comb/brush
- ☐ Other daily use personal toiletries (glasses/contacts, lotion, etc)

#### ***GIVEN TO YOUR TEACHER***

- ☐ Approved medications and written directions (with your name on it- teacher will oversee all medications)

#### ***OTHER IMPORTANT ITEMS***

- ☐ Water bottle

#### ***OPTIONAL ITEMS***

- ☐ Camera
- ☐ Binoculars
- ☐ Book
- ☐ Journal

**LEAVE THE FOLLOWING AT HOME:** candy, gum, extra food, hair dryers, hair spray, hair gels, makeup, perfume and body spray, games, iPods, cell phones, computer games, knives, or money.

**PACK YOUR GEAR IN A SUITCASE OR DUFFEL BAG.** Please bring only what you need and pack tightly. Students are responsible for carrying their own belongings from the bus into the Visitor Center.

**LOST ITEMS:** Please contact your students' teacher about lost and found items. A sweep of the entire Visitor Center is conducted before student departure and all unclaimed items are sent back to school with staff on the school bus. KMTA is not responsible for any lost items.
